## CARE GUIDE - METALS

## HOW TO CLEAN/POLISH

POWDER COATED IRON / STEEL / ALUMINIUM
To get rid of dirt and dust, mix a mild detergent with warm water. Dip a lint free cloth into the water \& wipe the item down with the cloth. If necessary, wipe the item dry with a soft dry cloth.
(Avoid scraping or rubbing the powder coating with an abrasive cloth that could damage or remove the coating from the surface)

HOW TO CLEAN / POLISH

## GLASS

Make sure the glass is clean for dust and dirt on all sufaces before you begin polishing. You can remove lime scale by using vinegar added water. Spray glass cleaner or hot water on the item. Use a dry cloth to spread the cleaner and wipe the item dry and shiny.
