


Thinking small, big and everything inbetween.


Fogia's take on sustainability is multi-layered, running from investment in our factory and the way we produce our furniture and design, to the materials we use and also the notion of sustainability in relation to design, quality and product lifecycle.



Textiles, down, feathers and leather.

The feathers, down and leathers we use and work with in Fogia's upholstery are all bi-products of other industries.

When it comes to fabrics and leather, Fogia has its own standard assortment which includes EU-Ecolabel and EkoTex standardised options. A customer is however free to select fabrics and leathers from outside our standard range accordingly.





Wood and Timber.

We strive to source wood from countries and managed forests in close proximity to our factory to reduce transit. In addition because our factory has its own saw mill, we prefer to source entire logs as part of our production process to get as much from each one as possible. Fogia choses to work with FSC-certified wood wherever possible and we regularly visit our factory and its suppliers to ensure the quality remains high.



Markings, certifications and standards Fogia adheres to.

MÖBELFAKTA

Möbelfakta (Furniture Facts) sets guidelines and certification for the furniture industry to ensure that a product is made according to recommended guidelines based on quality, environmental standards and social responsibility. It is a Swedish based standard which contains a comprehensive set of guidelines for furniture production.

FSC

The Forest Stewardship Council is an international body which sets standards for responsible forest management. It certifies sustainable forestry to safeguard resources for future generations, with more than 380 million acres of forest certified to its standards.

OEKO-TEX

The Standard 100 by Oeko-tex is a worldwide testing and certification system for raw, semi-finished and finished textile products across all levels of processing as well as accessory materials used. A highly scientific system, a textile or yarn is measured against hundreds of regulated substances before being certified, or not as the case often is. Oeko-tex is a certification system to help avoid the skin coming into contact with harmful substances.





Transport & Logistics.

Fogia pays careful attention to the transportation of its items into and out of its factory. We always co-load goods to minimise unnecessary emissions and deliver with our own truck to our transport hub. The advantage of producing in Central Europe is also reduced transit distances to international markets.
